Tips and Hints to find your perfect program:

Years ago, when our parents were young, the possibility of learning and traveling abroad was not as available as it is today. Sometimes, it was only realized by enrolling or being drafted in the military, and no one quite asked where you wanted to go.

No foxholes for our generation of youth who wish to study abroad or travel. Today there are a wealth of opportunities to choose from. Going abroad is not seen as such a rare luxury but as an essential experience for the well-rounded person. This is especially Yes for young Italian Americans. There is no better way to strengthen one's Italian American identity than by becoming immersed in the history, culture, language, and everyday life of Italy. There are programs for almost any area of study- from language, to fine art, to economics, and even science. Also, if you want to learn Italian, the experience is an excellent opportunity to become fluent. If language study is not a priority, many schools and programs in Italy teach strictly in English.

The problem that all students face after they have decided to go abroad is choosing a program. ***This Study Abroad in Italy Directory should hopefully give you a head start in researching programs which might be a good fit for what you want to accomplish.*** Please note that this is far from an exhaustive list, and that you should also check into alternate resources listed below.

Here are some more tips and resources to help you narrow down your search.

- **Choose your subject and city.** The first step is to decide what you want out of the ideal program. Do you want to go abroad just for the experience of being there? Do you want a program specifically geared for academic credit? Do you want to learn about a region? *Tip:* Entries for this study abroad directory are listed alphabetically by city.

- **Check out the programs.** Becoming informed on the programs that fit your criteria is the key.

1. Use the NIAF Study Abroad in Italy Directory to begin your search of programs. For most entries, even more information can be gathered by you through going to the program website listed in the program's entry, or by contacting the representative listed by mail, e-mail, fax or phone.

2. If you are still in school, a great place to continue your search is at your own **college study abroad office**. Most colleges have their own programs set up for study abroad in Italy, but if they don't, or the program doesn't appeal to you, they usually have contacts with other colleges and universities around the nation that sponsor different programs. An advantage to using your college's study abroad office is that these administrators have a wealth of contacts and experience in placing students in programs that will be tailored to their specific

desires. Also, they might suggest options that you never thought of before which could greatly enhance your adventure.

3. Another place to search is the **Internet**. You need to be careful, however, because not all the information might be current or credible. There are some sites that offer great search engines that you can use to narrow down your search- searches by subject, region, city, and type of program. A couple great sites to start with are www.studyabroad.com, www.istc.umn.edu, www.iie.org, and www.aifs.org.

4. There are also numerous **books** written on the subject. Check your local bookstore for more information.

• **Talk with someone who's been on the program before.** There is no better way to get a feel for a program than to talk with someone who has already done it. See what they liked about it, what living in Italy was truly like, what they didn't like about it, etc. Many of the Internet sites and study abroad offices have contacts of people who went on each program. You'll find that most people are more than willing to speak about their experience.

If you do not want to make the commitment for a semester or year, but are very interested in seeing if study in Italy might be for you, a great way to find out is to apply for our NIAF sponsored trip for students- **The Voyage of Discovery: Learning Exchange, Italy and America**. This week-and-a-half-long trip occurs each summer which focus on a different region of Italy each year. The program's itinerary includes educational lectures, meetings with government officials, business leaders and visits to government offices, international businesses, museums, and other cultural attractions. 80 students are picked each year to attend the program, which is all-expenses paid by the NIAF. Applications and further information can be viewed on our website: www.niaf.org/voyageofdiscovery. (Application deadline: December 15th).

There are also many scholarships for students who might not have the financial means to go abroad. A useful way to look up various scholarships is to perform a web based search on a portal (Yahoo, Google, etc.) for scholarship search engines or scholarship search services. One particularly good scholarship search engine is www.fastweb.com. Many of these search engines allow you to narrow your search to provide results pertaining only to your needs or preferences.

The most important thing to keep in mind is that you can realize your dream of going abroad with a little searching and hard work. Experiencing life abroad could be one of the most rewarding, eye-opening things that you do in your life. Take advantage of it.
